



Arrival by car

The KIT Campus East is located in the Karlsruhe city center and is well connected to the autobahn (highway). Please enter "Rintheimer Quelle 2b" into your navigational system.

Attention: Due to construction sites in and around Karlsruhe short-term road blocks and by-passes are possible, which we may not always be able to announce here.

Highway A5

- A5 exit Karlsruhe-Durlach, to Karlsruhe
- Follow "Durlacher Allee", take a right into "Haid-und-Neu-Straße" then turn left into "Hirtenweg", which leads directly onto "Rintheimer Quelle".

Arrival by train and public transport

Campus East is located in Karlsruhe city center and is easily reached by public transport.

End stop for guests: take tram 2 or S8 to "Hirtenweg/Technologiepark" and then go 10-15 minutes by foot.

Take bus line 30 to "Rintheimer Querallee" and then go 10-15 minutes by foot.
